



Shown above is the new Public Safety Complex which houses the Police and Fire Department Offices and a new fire training tower.




Finally, we prepared designs for the renovation and conversion of a vacant industrial building on Tolland Street for new offices of the East Hartford Public Schools Facilities Department.

Mansfield Connecticut will soon have a new **RV & Self Storage Facility**. Fifty-six thousand square feet of self storage space and 112 spaces for recreational vehicles was recently submitted and approved by the Town Planning and Zoning Commission.
