

Weathering the Storm... Flood Control Dams

During the heavy rainstorms of October, we were on "on-call" with the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection to visit and review state owned dams if needed. We were asked to look at several state flood control dams in the **Stafford** area on the day after the storm.

The dam with it's flood pool near it's high point. The water is about 20 feet above the inlet structure.





The outlet of the dam with the "normal" brook flow through the 24" pipe.

The same outlet pipe flowing full under pressure. Imagine a 24" diameter garden hose running full force.



All of the dams we visited performed just as they were intended to and there were no problems noted. Observing these dams in action just reinforced the old adage "never underestimate the power of moving water".
