
Did You Know...

Regulation Repealed

The Connecticut Stream Channel Encroachment Line (SCEL) program has been repealed by Public Act 2013-205 as of October 1, 2013. Established in response to the floods of 1955 to protect a river's flood carrying and storage capacity, the SCEL program duplicated the protections and regulations afforded by the more recent National Flood Insurance Program.
